



## **Inpatient ESSENTIAL VISITOR Policy/Guidelines**

At this time, Baton Rouge Rehab Hospital is allowing one **ESSENTIAL VISITOR** per inpatient and are asking the **ESSENTIAL VISITOR** to comply with the following guidelines while within the facility.

- **Inpatient Visiting hours** for **ESSENTIAL VISITORS** only will be as follows:
  - **Mon – Fri** between **7:30am–7:30pm**
  - **Sat & Sun** between **11:30am–4:00pm**
    - **(No entry after 3:00pm on weekends)**
- A facemask that **you** provide should be worn at all times while at BRRH.
- If you arrive upon admit, you will receive an **ESSENTIAL VISITOR Identification Bracelet**. If you arrive following admission, please see the primary nurse for the bracelet.
- Proceed directly to the patient's room and remain there for the duration of the visitation. At this time, no visitors will be allowed in the dining room.
- If at any time during the duration of your loved one's stay you experience signs and symptoms of COVID-19 or test positive for COVID-19, please contact Joy Miceli, Employee Health Nurse, at 231-3077.
- **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE GUIDELINES WILL RESULT IN THE ESSENTIAL VISITOR LEAVING THE HOSPITAL AND FORFEITING FURTHER VISITATION.**

In order to maintain the safest environment possible for our patients, employees, and visitors, compliance with the guidelines will be monitored by all hospital staff.
